

## **THINGS YOU CAN DO TO LOSE YOUR PUBLIC HOUSING ASSISTANCE**

- Arrests for ANY acts of violence, manufacturing, distributing, selling or possession of ANY illegal drugs by family members (on or off SHA property) or your guests.
- Arrests for sexual crimes against another person (HUD lifetime bad on sexual offenders and predators).
- Not paying your rent or not paying your rent in a timely manner over a period of time.
- Destroying your unit.
- Fraud or bribery, committed at time of admission or any time during the period that you are a resident of the housing authority. Fraud in not reporting all income, persons living in unit. Bribery to any housing authority employee or board member to assist you in obtaining or keeping housing.
- Not reporting all income changes within 10 days.
- Not reporting any and all income (Even if you are not given the money, if someone pays your utility bills, buys diapers, cleaning supplies, etc. This is considered In-Kind-Income).
- Having unauthorized persons living in your unit.
- Having any utilities that you are responsible for disconnected.
- Not showing up for Annual Re-certifications.
- Not allowing the Housing Authority to conduct inspections.
- Engaging in or threatening abusive or violent behavior towards SHA personnel.
- Allowing persons that you know to have been trespassed from Housing Authority property onto the property.
- Violation of Probation or Parole.
- Failing to disclose on you're Application for Admission or the Application for Recertification any information or falsifying any information on these documents.
